Thank you for calling as your call helps us improve our service.
I have found something that may work for you.

The starting point again is the "Find a room on the great ocean road" button and then select the other towns.

* In Advanced Search leave the location at "All Locations" and change the date to 28th and select one night for two adults. You will find "Seaview House" in Queenscliff having availability and that will be a pleasant first day's driving. A fall back alternative is the Portarlington Beach Motel.

* Back to advanced search and the date 29th and two nights gives you another list. FIRST IGNORE "GLENOE COTTAGES", they are unavailable and our support advises that they will be removed from the site shortly.

Apologies for the inconvenience and thank you for persevering. Apollo Bay has no availability, but there are two options in Warrnambool - Mantra Deep Blue sounds nice, Quamby Homestead is more rural and quite a bit out of the way, probably too far..

Suggested itinerary:

* Day one is a short drive from Melbourne airport to Queenscliff - a quaint holiday village on the Bellarine Peninsula.

* Day two is about 300 km to Warrnambool, but as you will be coming back you could do the Great Ocean Road in each direction, on the way down think of Lunch in Apollo Bay, then the Apostles and on to Warrnambool.

* Day three - take a trip to Port Fairy, Tower Hill if there is time and the Warrnambool waterfront is interesting in it's own right.

* Day four, your return to Melbourne for New Year's eve, focus on the Great Ocean Road between Apollo Bay and Torquay, if you can fit it in lunch at Chris' Beacon Point Restaurant. It will be a long but great start to New Year's Eve.
